#### PASTOR'S REFLECTION



We live in a world of instants. We want things to be done outright or wishes to happen instantly. We could hardly wait. But when we read the gospels, we see how patient Jesus was with his disciples. Jesus gave his disciples plenty of time to grow in their faith. They spent three years with Him and still they did not understand Him. He walked with the two on their way to Emmaus and let them tell their story of frustration. When they had finished expressing their feelings of disappointment, He explained to them the Scripture, and still, they did not understand. In today's gospel his patience

continues. He invited the disciples to

touch Him to feel that He is real, and He eats with them to prove that He is not a ghost. He shows them how Scripture backs him up.

Patience is not always easy to practice. It needs trust in people's goodness. It is built on the conviction that the final result will be positive. It relies on perseverance that can overcome initial setbacks. God has been so patient with us. We have questioned his teachings; we have demanded explanations and we have wondered if he is

### **Christ the King Church HISPANIC COMMUNITY**

Domingo 14 de Abril del 2024. (III Semana de Pascua).

Hermanas y hermanos, más allá de la tumba, un misterio celoso, casi arrogante, ciega nuestra mirada v desafía nuestra inteligencia. La muerte muestra con orgullo sus triunfos incesantes y reporta victoria sobre todos: niños y ancianos, hombres y mujeres, infelices que la han pretendido como escape desesperado, transeúntes que jamás hubieran querido encontrarse con ella. Sólo una cosa parece cierta y general: ante la puerta de la muerte habremos de comparecer todos.

Jesús en realidad quiere vencer esa distancia infinita que nos aparta de lo que no podemos controlar con nuestra inteligencia y por eso da a palpar su límite, esto es, la frontera que su misericordia ha querido visitar y habitar por nuestra salvación: "Tóquenme y convénzanse de que un fantasma no tiene ni carne ni huesos, como ven que vo tengo".

¡Ay, Dios! Y con semejante testimonio, que más claro no se le encontrará, ha habido todavía llamados teólogos que niegan la resurrección corporal del Señor... Tenga él piedad de ellos y de todos nosotros. Que si el primer impulso es castigar a quienes tales cosas enseñan, será mejor amar y compadecer, bien que sosteniendo firme la fe de los apóstoles y de la Iglesia entera. El evangelio nos explica, al fin v al cabo, que sólo cuando Dios abre el entendimiento es posible admitir que hubo una que rompió la trampa y escapó del vientre de la muerte. Se llama Jesucristo.

La segunda lectura de hoy da un paso más. La frase fundamental guizás es: "Sabemos que conocemos a Dios, si cumplimos sus mandamientos". La fe no es historia que endulza nuestros simplemente. La fe no es un relato épico que se contenta con tonificar el corazón. Es una fuerza de vida, y como tal tiene su lugar propio en la vida.

El apóstol Juan nos habla así en esta lectura porque ya en su tiempo hubo quienes pretendían que la fe era una "gnosis", es decir, un "conocimiento" destinado solamente a nuestra alma y sin una repercusión real ni en nuestro cuerpo ni en lo que hiciéramos con él Aquella "gnosis", que ha permanecido larvada o descarada durante los siglos, va por eso dando bandazos entre el desprecio que mutila lo corporal y el desafuero que predica y practica el libertinaje.


