He even worked miracles, and his reputation spread, that made people invite him to their synagogues. Yet, his visit was met with opposition from his townmates.

We are very critical when somebody’s teaching intends to change our lifestyle, we look at once for a loophole to break down the speaker’s credibility. We no longer look for the truth, but for justification of our behavior. We are no longer receptive to the good news which liberates us. We have a ready ear for people who talk against our religion, but we make no effort to know the true teaching of our church.

### **Christ the King Church - HISPANIC COMMUNITY By Father Ornelo Cherez Domingo 7 de Julio del 2024. (Semana XIV del tiempo ordinario).**

Hermanos y hermanas, la primera lectura de hoy describe con una palabra la actitud del pueblo que Dios se escogió: son un pueblo rebelde. Casi no podría ser mayor el contraste: Dios es persistente en amar y su pueblo es obstinado en huir del que le ama. ¿Por qué pasa así? La pregunta no es arqueológica sino existencial. Traducida al lenguaje de la virtud es: ¿Y por qué no somos santos? Esta rebeldía en el fondo es rechazo a la Palabra de Dios y deseo de seguir las propias "palabras." Y como a Dios por lo visto no se le puede hacer daño visible, el rechazo y desprecio a Dios se vuelve contra aquellos que hablan de parte de Dios, es decir, se vuelve contra sus profetas. Por esta razón pertenece al destino inevitable del profeta experimentar el repudio de su propia gente. Este es el pensamiento que atraviesa las lecturas de hoy, en particular, la primera y el evangelio.

El Señor le dice a Ezequiel: "sabrán que hubo un profeta." Es decir: la gente puede negar el contenido del mensaje pero de una o de otra forma tendrá que admitir que existió el mensajero, y que ese mensajero venía de Dios. En este sentido el profeta vence al final, pero el precio es morir a sí mismo y perder casi todo apoyo que no sea Dios.

El evangelio, por su parte, subraya otro peligro: lo que san Pablo llama "juzgar según la carne" o "según criterios humanos." Los paisanos de Jesús creían que lo conocían y por eso pensaban que podían deducirlo o explicarlo a partir de lo que habían visto de él, cuando en realidad no habían visto nada, porque los ojos de la gente suelen estar cerrados para el bien que no hace ruido ni se hace propaganda. Así que como no sabían nada de él juzgaban que nada se debía esperar de él: creían que lo conocían. El Cielo, adonde Dios nos lleve por su piedad, será un lugar de tremendas sorpresas. Descubriremos de seguro cuán poco conocimos de las personas que siempre tuvimos cerca, tan cerca, que eran como las páginas de un libro cuyas letras eran borrosas de tan pegadas a nuestros ojos.

Jesús se extrañó de la falta de fe de sus paisanos. Esto deja un tono de cierta melancolía a la reflexión de hoy. Perder la fe es perder el puente y la puerta a todo lo demás que sigue, y todo lo demás que sigue es grande. Perder la fe es escoger el hambre y desechar el pan. Señor: ten misericordia de nosotros.
